About The Role:

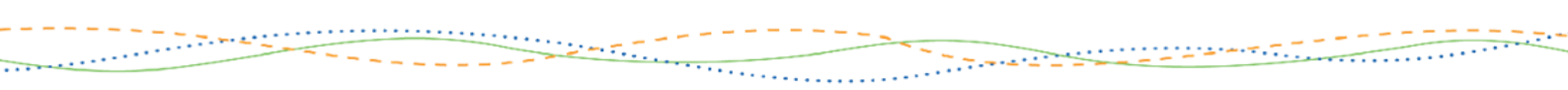
Whitsunday Regional Council is seeking enthusiastic and skilled **Casual Theatre Technicians** to join the team at the Proserpine Entertainment Centre.

 - Acting as Duty Technician for events and performances.
 - Maintaining technical equipment and ensuring safe operation in accordance with industry standards.
 - Participating in production and event meetings as required.

- Availability to work evenings, weekends and travel throughout the region when required.
